PROGRAM: Allison Black Cornelius – CEO, Greater Birmingham Humane Society (https://gbhs.org/)
Ivana Sullivan, who oversees various programs at GBHS, started the presentation. In 2014, BGHS took over for Jefferson County Animal Control. It helps the public with vaccines, dog houses, and many other ways. Some statistics from 2023: 6,282 animals were adopted & rehomed; 90,395 lbs of food were distributed through the "Goods Program"; 5,832 animals were spayed or neutered; 101 vet students trained. Ways to get involved: adopt; volunteer; be a transport driver; foster. If you witness animal cruelty, be sure to SNAP IT. MAP IT. CALL. Call GBHS Animal Care and Control at 205-591-6522.
Herbert Phillips began GBHS in 1883 as a place where children and animals were "kenneled". His belief was if you don't teach students to be sympathetic to animals and recognize suffering, they can't be good citizens.

Allison Cornelius has been with GBHS with 10 years. It is now the 10<sup>th</sup> largest impoundment facility in the U.S. They have formed a partnership with the Auburn University Veterinary School to give students a place to practice spaying and neutering dogs and cats. She shared some remarkable stories and encouraged everyone to participate in the annual Jazz Cat Ball.
